SNOW EMERGENCY PUBLIC INFORMATION

- 1. The Governor has declared a snow emergency for Massachusetts. The Selectmen have declared that as from 7:P.M. Monday, January 26, 2015, a local emergency exists in the Town of Dighton, Massachusetts.*
- 2. The PUBLIC SCHOOLS closed at noon today, will be closed tomorrow, Tuesday, January 27, and may reopen Wednesday, January 28, at a time to be announced.*
- 3. Dighton TOWN HALL will be closed tomorrow, Tuesday, January 27, and may reopen Wednesday, January 28. Employees will be called; opening time is to be determined. There will be a reasonable grace period for property taxes due February 2. Town office computers will be shut off during the emergency.*

4. No CURBSIDE TRASH PICKUP tomorrow, Tuesday, January 27. No trash pickup until 10:00 A.M. Wednesday. Do NOT put trash out the night before – only on morning of.

5. All persons within the boundaries of the Town of Dighton will refrain from non-emergency travel for the duration of this local emergency. A TOWN-WIDE PARKING BAN will be in effect after 4:00 P.M. on Monday, January 26, 2015; cars illegally parked in streets will be ticketed by police and may be towed.

6. DIGHTON-BERKLEY BRIDGE is closed Tuesday, January 26, 2015, to non-emergency travel. Public emergency responders will be given further information.

7. After the emergency, able residents should CLEAR SNOW AROUND FIRE HYDRANTS adjacent to their property, to insure that they are serviceable in case of fire.
