PUBLIC INFORMATION

- 1. A significant snowstorm is forecast for Sunday, February 8, 2015 thru Tuesday morning, February 10, 2015.*
- 2. A statewide snow emergency has been declared by the Governor.*
- 3. The PUBLIC SCHOOLS will be closed on Monday, February 9, 2015.*
- 4. PRIME TIME senior day care facility follows the public schools and will also be closed on Monday, February 9, 2015.*

5. The Dighton TOWN HALL opened at 0730 Monday, February 9, 2015. It is NOW CLOSED.

6. Delayed (1 hour) CURBSIDE TRASH PICKUP will begin at 8:00 A.M. This is a RECYCLE WEEK. Put trash/recycles out in the morning, not the night before.

7. A snow removal PARKING BAN will take effect at midnight (0001 February 9, 2015) and remain in effect at least until 0600 February 9, 2015.

8. DIGHTON-BERKLEY BRIDGE will be CLOSED 9:A.M. to 2:P.M. Monday, February 9, thru Wednesday, February 11, 2015. When open, essential travel only.

9. DIGHTON PUBLIC LIBRARY is closed today, Monday, February 09, 2015. Call (508)669-6421 for closing information.

10. No DIGHTON DISASTER COMMITTEE meeting Monday, February 9, 2015. All emergency preparedness and emergency response personnel carry on. Thank you and good luck.

11. Following the snowstorm, able residents please shovel snow from around FIRE HYDRANTS adjacent to your property for serviceability in case of fire.
