**Call to Order:**

Chairman Thomas Pires called the meeting to order at 6:30 P.M.

**Present:**

**New Business:**

**Outdoor Hydronic Heater, Bill Eccles; 3100 Elm Street Dighton** is requesting a special permit for a wood burning furnace.

**He was told that the Town is resubmitting new regulations for Outdoor Wood Burning Furnace to D.E.P.**

Mr. Eccles stated that the stack that he is planning to install will be in compliance with the 18' regulation. The Board requested the building Commissioner issue a building permit and inspect for compliance with regulations.

**Inspectors Reports:**

**Kevin Bernardo Health Agent:** Stated that he was conducting 2<sup>nd</sup> round of food inspections. He mentioned that the Dighton Rehoboth Grid Iron Club is serving food during football games and has not provided to the Board of Health the proper food handling documents or liability Insurance forms required to obtain a food permit and subsequently has not been inspected. The grid Iron is a nonprofit group and when all documentation has been provided the Board of Health voted to waive the application fees.

**Motion Dean Cronin step down second, Thomas Pires to waive the application fee for the food handling permit.**

**James Aguiar Building Commissioner:** Stated that Annual Safety Certificates are up for renewal. All establishments will be visited. Inspections will end the end of October beginning of November.

**1886 County Street “Daddio’s”**

The building has been vacant for many years. The water, gas and electric were shut off by the Building Commissioner at the street when the back of the building collapsed. In order to operate many town boards will need to inspect and give their approvals. Thomas Pires stated that they will a Title V will probably needed.

Bob Mullen from the Dighton Lions reminded everyone that the 10<sup>th</sup> Annual Arts Festival will be held at Araujo Farms on November 2, 2014 and there will be a shuttle from Manheim New England to Araujo’s.
