Review/Discuss/Act: Professional Engineering Services

Highway Superintendent, Thomas Ferry appeared before the Board with Paul Guertin, PE of Coler & Colantonio, Norwell presenting a program for the Town to pursue SAFETEA-LU funding for roadway improvements. The SAFETEA-LU Funding Program, established by the MA Highway, is to help cities and towns preserve and enhance historic character, environmental assets and other unique community characteristics when implementing necessary roadway improvements.

Coler & Colantonio is proposing to prepare information (a/k/a Phase I – Project Need Form (PNF)) for submission to the MA DOT requesting to improve Tremont Street commencing at Somerset Avenue and extend west to Burt Street. Mr. Guertin proposes that the work to prepare a PNF be performed on an hourly basis and that the budget be established at \$2,000.00 and will not exceed said amount without written authorization from the client. The Town will be under no obligation to expend any other funds than those associated with preparing preliminary assessments which is quoted at \$2,000.00.

Once approval from MADOT is received and the Town agrees to move forward it may be determined by the district engineers that a Project Planning Report (PPR) will be required and it is estimated that a median budget of \$10,000.00 be allocated. The Town's participation can involve using a portion of their Chapter 90 funds to finance the engineering services. Said funding for this step will be presented at a Town Meeting.

Review/Discuss/Act: Ballot Question Proposal for a new Police Headquarters and Communications Center

At the Annual Town Meeting of June 12, 2012 the Town approved to see if the Town will vote to borrow \$2,500,000.00 for a term of no more than 20 years to pay costs to design, construct, furnish and equip a new Police headquarters and Communications center including all costs incidental and related thereto, authorize the Board of Selectmen to contract for in the name of the Town and do all things necessary for the accomplishment of this purpose, to authorize the Board of Selectmen to contract for and expend any state or federal grants; any gifts or donations; and/or any other sums of money obtained for such purpose, provided, however, this approval is contingent upon a debt exclusion vote. Said action must go to a Ballot vote that will take place at the Special Election on August 9th. Motion: Thomas J. Pires, seconded: Dean V. Cronin VOTED to approve the August 9, 2012 ballot question as follows: Shall the Town of Dighton be allowed to exempt from the provisions of proposition two and one-half, so-called, the amounts required to pay for the bonds to be issued in order to finance the design, construction, furnishing and equipping of a new Police headquarters and Communication center, including all costs incidental and related thereto?
