The Dighton Board of Selectmen met with the Rehoboth Board of Selectmen at the Rehoboth Senior Center on Route 118, Rehoboth, Massachusetts, at 7:30 o'clock P.M. on the evening of Monday, 25 August 2014. Selectmen Dean V. Cronin, Thomas J. Pires, and Patrick W. Menges, met with Selectmen Michael Costello, Frederick "Skip" Vadnais, David Perry, Joseph Tito, and Susan Pimental.

The following excerpt of minutes of the meeting prepared by Town Administrator Jeffrey Ritter is provided by the Rehoboth Board of Selectmen:

Action Item #1: Meet with Dighton Board of Selectmen: M. Costello welcomed the Board of Selectmen from the town of Dighton and stated that this is a good opportunity to start a discussion about sharing resources and equipment.

Selectman Dean Cronin from Dighton agreed we have an opportunity to problem solve together and the concept of quarterly meetings between the two Boards is a wonderful idea and much needed.

M. Costello said we have to be good neighbors and brought up the issue of the cost for Town Meeting coverage and asked about charging a different rate.

S. Vadnais asked about the Regional School District assessment and the Regional Agreement that both issues need attention.

D. Cronin agreed but first would want to have the opportunity of discussing both matters with his Board in advance of any discussions with Rehoboth. But yes, as a Board and as representatives of the community we would agree to discuss these issues.

M. Costello referenced two areas the two Towns are already working together. The first was a records management grant application and the other area is a feasibility study for a joint dispatch center.

The Dighton selectmen withdrew at 8:30 P.M., constituting an adjournment by dissolution without day.
