### **Joint Meeting With the Planning Board**



The Dighton Board of Selectmen met with the Dighton Planning Board in the planning board office at 979 Somerset Avenue, Dighton, Massachusetts, at 6:0'clock P.M. on Wednesday, 6 May 2015, to hear a presentation by an independent energy services provider seeking to expedite solar energy generation at the former sanitary landfill site on Tremont Street and to engineer budget-neutral municipal energy saving solutions. In addition to the Planning Board and the presenters, Selectmen Chairman Dean V. Cronin, Clerk Patrick W. Menges, and Selectman Matthew W. Tanis, and Building Commissioner James D. Aguiar, Jr., were present.

The selectmen were required to serve at a 6:30 P.M. board of health meeting, and withdrew from the planning board office without having participated except to audit the proceedings up to that time, at 6:22 P.M. It was the consensus of the selectmen that the energy services provider needs to meet with the selectmen prior to undertaking any act concerning the former landfill on Tremont Street.
