Announcements were read. Chairman Pires noted that he anticipates presenting a warrant article at Special Town Meeting requesting funding to host a Hazardous Household Waste Day.

The Board prepared and presented a letter to owners of Hillcrest Estates requiring that the storm water detention/retention area be fenced in immediately as required by the Regulation of November 29, 2004. Health Agent James Aguiar, Jr., reported that the Summer Camp Reporting will be completed and submitted as required. Perc tests have been performed at the Cedar Street property. Various proposed bylaws are completed and are being reviewed by Attorney, Lisa Meade. Calls have gone unanswered relative to the Daddio's establishment located on County Street, but the building is secure.

Health Agent Kevin Bernardo – reported that he has completed Temporary Food Permit inspections. An order to clean up property located on Somerset Avenue has been issued. C&N Pizza located on County Street currently has a violations that must be corrected before the sale of property is approved.
