Discuss Pedestrian Light for Main Street & Route 138

The meeting was arranged by the Board of Selectmen, ADA Officer and SRPEDD with MassDOT to address concerns and a correction plan of pedestrian accommodations, as well as, bringing the curb ramps, crosswalks and sidewalks into compliance with ADA. It was noted by Edward Feeny of MassDOT that a stop light is not warranted as presented by the SRPEDD traffic study performed in January 2009. Further, it was noted that the speed limit could not be reduced. It was determined that MassDOT will look into bringing the curb ramps, crosswalks and sidewalks within compliance with ADA, bring appropriate signage up to date and contact the utility company to relocate the poles obstructing the view.
