Dean V. Cronin called the emergency meeting to order at 9:02 AM.

Present: Dean V. Cronin, Thomas J. Pires and Thomas Ferry, Highway Superintendent

The pledge of allegiance was recited.

Review/Act on Options for Contaminated Soil at the Highway Garage

Highway Superintendent, Thomas Ferry, appeared before the Board to discuss the cleanup of the contaminated soil at the Highway Garage. Mr. Ferry presented and the Board reviewed and discussed the proposal from Green Seal Environmental that gives the Town two options to close the sites. It was determined that the town will choose Option 1 for \$23,000.00 because said option ensures that all contaminants are removed.

It was determined that the total cost incurred for cleanup is \$131,000 and the estimated total cost is at \$160,000. However, the number could increase because the cost does not include the disposal of the contaminated soil and another underground tank filled with water was found in the front of the property. Further, additional costs will be incurred as monitoring wells will be required. It was noted that no contaminates have leaked into the groundwater.

Motion: Thomas J. Pires, seconded: Dean V. Cronin VOTED to select Option 1 in the amount of \$23,000 as proposed by Green Seal Environmental.
