Discuss Interim Superintendent for the Dighton Rehoboth Regional School District and Principal for Dighton-Rehoboth High School

The Board discovered through the Sun Chronicle Newspaper that the Dighton-Rehoboth Regional School District has named an interim superintendent, Michael Malone, and a new High School principal, Jacqueline Striano. The Board made several unsuccessful attempts to reach the School Committee members representing the Town of Dighton for comment. As such, the Board took the opportunity to reach out to the Dighton elected committee members to help keep the lines of communication open as the recent action has a significant impact on students within the Town.

Review/Discuss/Act: Acceptance of resignation for Police Station Committee Member

The Board received and read a letter of resignation from the Police Station Committee.

Discuss Status Update of Police Station Committee

The Town has acquired a gift of land on Somerset Avenue from Dighton Power which will provide the site location for a new police station. A request for proposal has been prepared for a project manager and preliminary design plans are 80% complete, subject to revisions. Once a project manager is selected all information needed for the USDA loan will be submitted. Although the project is at an estimate of 10 months behind schedule, the Board assures townspeople that the project is not on the back burner and that it will be brought to completion. The Board would like to thank the committee for their efforts and to Dighton Power for the gift of land.

Review/Discuss/Act: End of Year Budget Transfer Request(s)

The Board received and read various End of Year Budget Transfer Request in accordance with MGL Ch. 44, Sec. 33B as amended by Chapter 77 of the acts of 2006.

Cronin VOTED to approve the end of the year budget transfer request from Highway Department, Part-Time Payroll Account to Highway Department Gasoline and Diesel Fuel Account in the amount of \$7,012.60 to cover fuel costs over what was anticipated for fiscal year 2013.

Cronin VOTED to approve the end of the year budget transfer request from Highway Department, Full-Time Payroll Account to Highway Department Public Works Supplies Account in the amount of \$5,018.41 to cover expenses greater than expected for various projects the department has accomplished for fiscal year 2013.

Review/Discuss/Act: Legal Services for Surrounding community Casino Mitigation Matters

The Board received a proposal from Steven A. Torres, Esquire of Pannone, Lopes, Devereaux & West, LLC to represent the Town in connection with the development of the proposed Mashpee Wampanoag destination resort casino project (Taunton) including negotiation of surrounding community mitigation agreements in the amount of not exceeding \$8,500.00. After discussion it was determined that the Board will not obtain the services of Attorney Torres due to lack of funding and that the Board will apply on their own. Motion: Patrick W. Menges, seconded: Dean V. Cronin VOTED to notify Steven A. Torres, Esquire of Pannone, Lopes, Devereaux & West, LLC that the Town of Dighton will apply with out his assistance.

Discuss Industrial Development Financing Authority

The Board is seeking to reactivate the Industrial Development Financing Authority (MGL Ch. 40D, Sec. 2) originally adopted on June 25, 1973, consisting of five members, which must include a banker, realtor and town official. Said Financing Authority is needed to expand industry within the municipality and will work closely with the Board of Selectmen, Planning Board as they work on the Master Plan and the State Economic Development.

Review/Discuss/Act: Letter of Support for the Tennis Court Revitalization Project Application to the Community Preservation Committee

The Parks and Recreation Department is seeking for the Board's support for their application to the Community Preservation Committee for the Tennis Court Revitalization Project located on Somerset Avenue. It was noted, the Board is not aware of opposition to the project. Motion: Patrick W. Menges, seconded: Dean V. Cronin VOTED to support the Parks & Recreation Commission's Tennis Court Revitalization Project.


