

BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONS – MINUTES 2017
February 27, 2017

Meeting opened at 4:30 P.M.

Present: William Mendoza, Carol Beauregard, Supt. Harold Gracia and Dianne Curtis were present.

Minutes: Minutes of February 6th were approved. Signatures instead of initials were added to the January 4th and January 23rd minutes.

Bills were signed.

Discussion of Letter to Atty. David Gay Re: Sewer Department and Employee: The Board reviewed the letter sent to Attorney David Gay regarding the Sewer Department. Chairman William Mendoza stated that Attorney Gay was contacted to make a simple inquiry. There was general discussion regarding the inquiry to Attorney Gay and other correspondence that was sent to him by the Board of Selectmen. Carol Beauregard motioned to send a response letter to the Board of Selectmen in regards to the letter sent to Attorney David Gay criticizing the Board of Sewer Commissioners; William Mendoza stepped down as Chair and seconded the motion; all ayes; none opposed; motion passes.

Update the Board Re: Stonegate Landing Pump Station: Chairman Mendoza stated that Richard Feodoroff has been in touch with the Sewer Department in regards to Stonegate Landing. Mr. Mendoza stated that Mr. Feodoroff stated that he would like to build the ten homes and put E-1 pumps in those homes instead of the pump station that he originally planned on. Mr. Mendoza stated that he would like to speak with the Zoning Board of Appeals, to get their comment or act on this.


Update on Audit for Sewer Department on February 23, 2017: There was discussion regarding the Audit for the Sewer Department that took place on Thursday, February 23, 2017. It was stated that the Audit seemed to go very well. The Auditor questioned why there were remarkable differences in flows. Supt. Harold Gracia stated there are a few reasons for the variations such as rain amounts, Bristol County Agricultural High School- when the students are/are not in school and the various activities, Aquaria flow varies, etc. Supt. Gracia will make a statement to submit to the Auditor.

Superintendent's Report: Supt. Gracia stated that an industry in the mill had contacted the Sewer Dept. to do a small chemical discharge. This company sent us a 30-page lab analysis report. Supt. Gracia requested for Dianne Curtis to forward this to the City of Taunton. Mrs. Curtis stated that she had requested that the company keep us updated but there has been no response as of yet.

Carol Beauregard motioned to adjourn at 5:38 pm; William Mendoza stepped down as Chair and seconded; all ayes. Meeting adjourned.
