

BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONS – MINUTES 2017
November 27, 2017

Meeting opened at 4:30 P.M.

Present: William Mendoza, Paul Joly, Carol Beauregard, Supt. Harold Gracia and Dianne Curtis.

Minutes: Minutes of November 13th were approved.

Richard Feodoroff Re: Stonegate Landing Pump Station: Richard Feodoroff met with the Board and Supt. Harold Gracia to discuss the pump station plans for Stonegate Landing. Chairman William Mendoza explained to Mr. Feodoroff that the Board of Sewer Commissioners cannot move forward until plans are approved by Zoning Board of Appeals. Mr. Feodoroff explained to the Board the reason he would like AECOM to review the plan for the pump station prior to meeting with Z.B.A. The Board and Supt. Gracia advised Mr. Feodoroff that he must have definitive plans that have been approved by Z.B.A. The Board stated to Mr. Feodoroff that they will take his request under advisement.

Austin Donahue Re: 811 Somerset Avenue: The Board discussed the location of the sewer stub at 811 Somerset Avenue.

2018 Drain-Layer Renewal for B. Conway Construction, Inc.: The Board reviewed the Drain-Layer License Renewal Application for B. Conway Construction, Inc. for 2018. Carol Beauregard motioned to approve B. Conway Construction, Inc. as a Licensed Drain-Layer for 2018, with a Bond renewal due in April of 2018; Paul Joly seconded the motion; all ayes; none opposed; motion passes.

Superintendent's Report:

Supt. Gracia met with the Fire Chief at the Park Street Pump Station regarding the fire alarms there.

Supt. Gracia stated that he noted that the dumpster for the Park Street Pump Station upgrade project is being filled with other debris other than that of the upgrade project debris. He stated that it is possible that the neighboring residents may be taking advantage of the open dumpster.


Supt. Gracia stated that land clearing is taking place for the new Dighton Police Station. There was brief discussion of recently submitted plans for the new Police Station.

Supt. Gracia discussed with the Board the new manhole risers needed for the Highway Department.


Carol Beauregard motioned to adjourn at 5:22 P.M.; Paul Joly seconded; all ayes. Meeting adjourned.
