### MEETING MINUTES:

1. Meeting was called to order at 5:01pm by Chairman Kevin Smith Jr.
  - People Present

2. Old Business
  - North Dighton fencing and lighting:
    - SouthEast Fence has completed their portion of the fencing project. Highway department will be finishing up the remaining areas.
    - BP has volunteered to replace the lighting, saving \$8,000-\$10,000, which will be given back to the CPC.
  - North Dighton Playground:
    - Kompan has completed installation
    - Turf will be put in next week, then a community day will be planned to spread mulch and sand.
    - ADA mats will be placed during the community day event, after mulch and sand are in place
  - Rec'n Crew members are being asked to help during the playground community day to spread mulch and sand and plant flowers.
3. New Business
  - Sue Cote motioned to accept the donation from Tscapes Inc. in the amount of \$370.00 for landscape materials. Rachel Goulart seconds. Motion passes unanimously
  - Looking into welcome sign for the North Dighton Playground.
  - Discuss installation of no parking signs to be placed in parking lot of North Dighton Playground
4. Public Input
  - Linda Hay thanks the Commission for making the playground accessible. She has had issues getting through other playgrounds and looks forward to being able to bring her great-granddaughter to this park.
  - Concerns about lighting from neighbors. They would like lights to automatically go off at a reasonable hour. Commission is hoping to have the light on a 10pm timer.

- Leonard Hull has concerns about vandalism to the new playground and asks if video surveillance would be possible. Commission agreed to discuss and further look into the logistics of that option, and put it as a topic of discussion on a future meeting agenda.
