Capital Outlay Discussion: The Board discussed the amount needed for capital outlay projects. Paul Joly motioned to request \$90,300 for FY 2023 and intend to purchase a basic four- wheel drive truck within the next 1 – 3 years, Tom Ferry seconded the motion, all in favor, motion passes.

Power Products: The Commissioners discussed the planned service contract for the 6 pump stations with Superintendent Gracia. There was a small increase from last year. The amount changed from \$1,635.00 to \$1,725.00 (\$90.00). Paul Joly motioned to approve the provided quote, Tom Ferry seconded the motion, all in favor, motion passes.

Power Plant Propane: Superintendent Gracia will check the Power Plant propane tank.

Old Business:

As-built 949 Somerset Ave: Superintendent Gracia provided an as-built.

Superintendent's Report: Mr. Gracia received a call from Weston & Sampson (Justin Gould) about scheduling a walk-through at BCAHS.

The Lincoln Ave pump station had a high- level alarm, a new part has been ordered.


There were power failures at the Town Hall, Rt 138 and Power Plant stations. No damage was done.

Paul Joly motioned to adjourn at 5:56 P.M.; Thomas Ferry seconded; all ayes. Meeting adjourned.


