

BOARD OF SEWER COMMISSIONS – MINUTES 2020
August 10, 2020

PUBLIC HEARING TO SET FY 2021 SEWER RATES

Meeting opened at 5:00 P.M.

Present: Paul Joly, Thomas Ferry, Robert Woods via Zoom, Supt. Harold Gracia and Dianne Curtis.

There was no Public Input for the Sewer Rates.

Set Rates for Sewer Billings FY 2021 (Aug. 2020 & Feb. 2021): Thomas Ferry motioned to maintain the current Sewer rates for FY 2021; Paul Joly stepped down as Chair and Seconded; all ayes; none opposed; motion passes for the Rates:

- 1.) Residential base will remain the same: \$120.00 and the sewer usage rate remains the same at .026 per cubic foot.
- 2.) Large Industry will remain the same: \$165.00 Per Unit and the usage fee remains the same at .058 per cubic foot of wastewater discharge.
- 3.) Small Industry will remain the same: \$165.00 Per Unit and the usage fee remains the same at .051 per cubic foot.
- 4.) Commercial will remain the same: \$130.00 Per Unit and the usage fee remains the same at .028 per cubic foot.
- 5.) Municipal will remain the same: \$130.00 and the usage fee remains the same at .028 per cubic foot.

Aquaria Desalination Plant is based on discharge readings proportionate to Dighton Flow + TSS + BOD


Residential users will continue to be given a 20% discount for outside usage and be charged 80% of water usage; all other users will be charged 100% of water usage.

All fees collected by the Sewer Enterprise are used to operate and maintain the current sewer system.


Paul Joly stepped down as Chair and motioned to close the Public Hearing Meeting; Thomas Ferry seconded; all ayes; none opposed; motion passes.
