

Notice to Dighton Residents

Effective July 11, 2016 **Single-Stream Recyclables** will now be collected on a **WEEKLY** basis. There will be no need to remember if it's a recycle week or not. Every week is now a "recycle week"!

Along with this upgrade of service your collection day may also be changed. Please refer to the street listing on the back of this flier to find your updated collection day.

Trash and Recyclables must be set out curbside by 7 am on your collection day.

Single Stream Recycling is a simplified means of recycling that eliminates the need for separating your recyclable material. All Recyclables can go in one bin.

Items that can be recycled: Newspaper, Magazines, Catalogs, Soft Cover Books, Junk Mail/Envelopes, Paper, Paperboard (Cereal/Shoe Boxes) Cardboard, Brown Paper Bags, Plastics marked #1-#7, Glass Bottles and Jars, Aluminum Pie Plates/Trays, Metal Cans (Tin/Steel/Aluminum) **All containers must be clean**

Items that can not be recycled: Plastic Bags, Ceramics, Dishes, Pyrex, Unmarked Plastics, Light Bulbs, Windows, Foam Packaging/Styrofoam, Aerosol Cans, Coat Hangers, Paint Cans, Pots/Pans, Batteries, 5-Gallon Pails, Laundry Baskets, Motor Oil/Antifreeze Containers, Paper Towels, Paper Plates, Aluminum Foil, Straws

Please Remember - Cardboard must not exceed 2'x2'
Recyclables set out inside plastic bags can not be taken
Shredded paper, newspapers may be set out in brown paper bags or small cardboard boxes
Dirty pizza boxes are not recyclable

Trash will be collected on the same day as your recyclables.

- Trash must consist of common household trash only. Yard waste, construction material, hazardous waste, etc. can not be taken.
- All waste must be placed securely inside an official Town of Dighton Bag and the bag must be tied. Trash not set out in this manner can not be taken.
- Bags must not weigh more than 50 pounds and must not be torn. Bags with excessive weight will rip and the contents will be spilled. Excessively heavy or torn bags can not be taken.

Important Reminders

****Needles, Syringes, Lancets and Sharps are banned from both Trash and Recyclable Waste.**

****Barrels must not exceed 40 gallon size and must not weigh more than 50 pounds**

****During Holiday weeks there will be a 1 day delay on the Holiday and each remaining day of that week**
